CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CLUB OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS

ALL OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS MUST:

- Display consistently high standards of behaviour, conduct and appearance at all times
- Never use foul, sexist, racial or abusive language
- Follow all guidelines laid down by BARLA, RFL and the Club
- Hold appropriate valid qualifications where relevant and ensure that you continue to develop via the Continuous Professional Development Program
- Consider the well-being and safety of players above all else, ensure that all equipment and facilities meet safety standards and report any concerns to the committee
- Develop and appropriate working relationship with players based on mutual trust and respect
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part, whilst remaining fun and for enjoyment of each child
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport at all times (e.g. fair play) and always operate to the principal of 'Friendship first – competition second'
- Never exert undue influence over players to obtain personal benefit or reward
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
